The issues of defining a research problem, importance of triangulation of data and data authentication were discussed. Second part of the session was again held by the resource person who gave guidance about areas like questionnaire formation, data sources, importance of observation in research and the choice of right kind of research methodology tools.

At the end, the importance of the workshop and future uses were summed up by the Dean Research- Dr.VikasPeshwe.

c. FDP on Case Pedagogy :A Faculty Development Workshop was Conducted at IndSearchBavdhan Campus, Pune on "Case Pedagogy in Management Teaching" on 4th& 5th October,2019.

On 7th February, Dr. Pohekar conducted an interactive session about the "Art and Science of Writing Research Papers". The discussion was about dos and don'ts of writing research papers in order to give qualitative output.
