7.1 Faculty Development programme on Advanced Excel by Prof. Upendra Lele

A 20 hours Faculty Development Workshop was by IndSearch on Quantitative Techniques in Excel from 22nd July 2021 to 20th August 2021.

The programme was conducted at IndSearch Bavdhan Campus, Pune as well as on the Microsoft Teams platform.

The Workshop was conducted by Prof. Upendra Lele, Head computing center- IndSearch.

The objective of the programme was to familiarize the faculty members of IndSearch with tools and concepts frequently used in data analysis and research. The emphasis of the programme was on conceptual learning as well as practical demonstrations

In extensive sessions, Professor Lele demonstrated areas relate to

Navigation, Calculations, VLOOKUP, String operations, working with date format, Costs Projections, Geometric Mean - average rate of return, Graphical representation using charts, Named Ranges, Worksheet protection, Pivot Tables for data aggregation, Use of Goal Seek function, Use of IF statement for Result computation, Time series - trend forecasting - Covid data India, Time series - trend forecasting - NAV data, Time series forecasting with seasonality, Two sample t test - diet and weight loss, One way ANOVA - golf ball distance travelled, Two way ANOVA - diet and weight loss, Multiple Regression - Car price prediction, Chi-square test of Independence, Logistic Regression - Heart disease prediction, Simulation using Excel, Data Tables - single variable, Data Tables - two variables, Matrix Operations, Realstat installation instructions

The workshop was attended by IndSearch Faculty from Bavdhan as well as Law college road campus.

8.1 Webinar on Industry Connect

On behalf of placement team of the Institute, Prof. Manjari Lal attended a webinar on Industry connect organized by AICTE on 22nd July 2021. During the session, Dr. Chandrashekhar Buddha introduced the participants to the AICTE Internship Portal (http://internship.aicte-india.org) and their collaborations with industries from different domains.

AICTE Chairman Prof Dr. Anil Sahasrabuddhe spoke about the need of industries to cooperate with Institutes and appealed to them to help.

Mr. Om Gupta from Microsoft spoke about transforming, reskilling, upskilling in the digital economy. Within a decade, 77% of jobs will require technology skills so the need for transformation.

Ms. Sandhya from NASSCOM spoke about the changes that are affecting the way we live. She spoke about the technical and professional skills that are necessary for todays economic development.

Mr. Ishvinder Singh from Cisco informed about their contribution through Cisco Networking Academy Program to prepare workforce of the future.



8.2 AICTE webinar series on 1 year of transformational leadership under NEP 2020

Faculty members attended the AICTE Webinar Series commencing from 30th July 2021 up to 10th August 2021. Also, on each of these days, the faculty conducted a webinar for the students, giving a gist of the topics discussed in the AICTE webinar.





8.3 IndSearch Webinar on National Educational Policy

IndSearch has organized an online Webinar on National Educational Policy, 24th April, 2021 to all stakeholders namely faculty, students and society for demystification of New Education Policy 2020.

The session was started by Dr. Satish Inamdar, followed by the inaugural address by our Director General, Dr. Ashok Joshi. Dr. Joshi has guided on the need for the newer education policy and key issues related to the existing policy such as higher school dropout ratios, lack of technology, lack of infrastructure for adult education and issues related to the research funds. Dr. Rupali Gupte than started the first session – aspects of school education. The main agenda was to understand the key challenges faced by the school education policy which mainly includes challenges in the previous policies and how the current education policy is eliminating the same by giving due importance to pre-primary education. This mainly includes, Identifying the various abilities of the students and developing them, Special considerations on life skills, imparting ethics, Developing life skills, and including a more stricter regulatory systems.

The session is then taken forward by Dr Sunetra Gaitonde, who then highlighted the aspects of school education and basics skills needed by the teachers. The key points which are being covered includes Current teacher quality is not up to the mark hence as a part of the education policy 2020 meritorious teachers is to be recruited. Incentives are to be given for teaching in rural areas, Transfers will be more transparent, continuous growth opportunities are to be given to the teachers, more leadership workshops are to be conducted, teachers will be given autonomy to choose pedagogy, teachers will be only concentrating on teaching learning activities only and will not be involved in administrative activities.

Dr. Vikas Peshave conducted the next session which included the key points related to the regulatory bodies needed for implementing the education policy. The key points that were covered are, National Research foundation is founded, and appropriate funding will be given. More teachers and students will be motivated to conduct research activities, Governance is divided into four compartments. National Higher education Council, National Accreditation Council (For improvising the quality of institutes), Higher education Councils (to provide grants), General Education Council. Higher education board will be the single regulator will control the higher education. Institutes can start their own online education and the open distance learning courses. Restructuring of the institutes will be done so that more number of students can be accommodated. Stage wise accreditation will be given and autonomy will be most important and institutes will be motivated to multidisciplinary.

The next session was conducted by Dr. Suwarna Shidore, who then discussed about the key highlights of adult education. The main points that were discussed are, Professional education should involves ethics, interdisciplinary districts, Preparation of professionals in agricultural education and veterinary science, The basic aim of the policy is to get 100% adult literacy and promotion of Indian language, Arts and culture. Importance is given for preserving of Indian Cultural wealth by promoting Indian languages and Indian arts.

The last session was conducted by Dr. Anand Chitanand who discussed about the financial aspects and the implementation of education policy. Also some of the current programs such as Skill India Mission, Beti Bachao Beti padhao, Ek Bharat Shretha Bharat programs which the government has already implemented as a part of education policy implementation.

The vote of thanks was given by Dr Satish Inamdar and the session was concluded by our Director - Dr. Aparna Tembulkar.


The institute has published a monograph based on this webinar.


8.8 Webinar on Career Counselling and Guidance for BMS





Prof. Ashwini Joshi, faculty member and Incharge of Women Entrepreneurship Development Cell at IndSearch, coordinated the workshop.



We had received total 8 entries from our students for this essay competition. The contents of the essays submitted by the students were very thoughtful & informative. Following were the winners of this essay competition:


